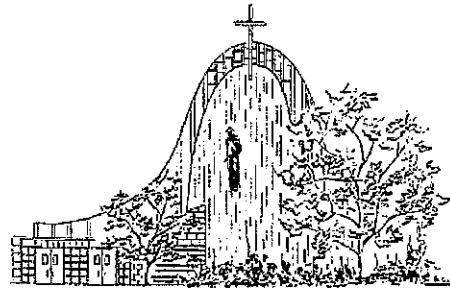

EXPLANATION OF VOLUNTEER POSITIONS

Catechist – teaches religious education curriculum to the students each week. There will be a set lesson plan that includes review of the weekly Gospel. (A teacher's guide is provided with answers and explanations)

Substitute Teacher – will fill in when a catechist is cannot make it in. There will be a lesson plan ready.

Hall Monitor – mans the door to make sure doors are unlocked then locked and that children go to their correct classes. They also collect the attendance sheets and bring them to the office.

Teacher's aide – assists the teacher in the classroom. Make copies, take young children to the restroom, collects work and helps with classroom craft.

Office help – help in the office during class time.

Service Projects- 8th graders will be doing community service work and sometimes we need additional adults to help chaperone and organize.

Christmas Pageant – help/donate goodies during their rehearsals.
